WA State Election – 8 March 2025

About the Role

The Western Australian Electoral Commission is offering a unique opportunity for school students to learn about and participate in electoral processes during the upcoming WA State Election.

- **Location:** Various polling places across the Perth metropolitan area
- **Hours:** 7:00 am – 6:00 pm, Saturday, 8 March 2025
- **Duration:** 1 day only

No prior experience is necessary, and you **do not** need a resume, cover letter, or National Police Clearance to apply.

Note: Places are limited, and applying does not guarantee a position.

Eligibility Criteria

To apply for a Student Electoral Officer role, you must meet the following requirements:

- Under 18 years of age** on or before 8 March 2025
- Over 16 years of age**, or turning 16 before 8 March 2025
- Available to work a maximum of **12 hours on Election Day**
- Have the **right to work in Australia**

If you are 18 or will turn 18 on or before 8 March 2025, you can apply for an **Ordinary Issuing Officer adult role** under General Polling positions.
